PAPER CHAIN

Instead of tinsel, make a paper chain for your Christmas tree or walls. You can use white or coloured paper, even old magazines or used paper, to make the paper strips.

1. Get an adult to help you cut the strips into 1.5cm by 10-12cm lengths – depending on how big you want the loops.
2. Take one strip and glue the ends together to make circle. Then thread the next strip through the first loop and glue its ends together.
3. Repeat until you are happy with the length of your paper chain.

CHRISTMAS COUNTDOWN

Make a colourful paper chain with 24 links. Each day from 1 December, kids tear off a link until Christmas Eve. Each link can have a fun fact or activity written inside (e.g., “Draw a bauble,” “Sing Jingle Bells”).
