PAPER CHAIN

Instead of tinsel, make a paper chain for your Christmas tree or walls. You can use white or coloured paper, even old magazines or used paper, to make the paper strips.

- 1. Get an adult to help you cut the strips into 1.5cm by 10-12cm lengths – depending on how big you want the loops.
- 2. Take one strip and glue the ends together to make circle. Then thread the next strip through the first loop and glue its ends together.
- 3. Repeat until you are happy with the length of your paper chain.

CHRISTMAS COUNTDOWN

Make a colourful paper chain with 24 links. Each day from 1 December, kids tear off a link until Christmas Eve. Each link can have a fun fact or activity written inside (e.g., "Draw a bauble," "Sing Jingle Bells").
